

About the Statement Issued on Japan's Constitution Day

This is the 60th anniversary of the Japanese Constitution, which is known as the Peace Constitution. On this occasion, the Law Section of the Association of Democratic Scientists, an academic society which has about 700 Japanese democratic lawyers as its members, has released a statement which confirms the positive significance of the Constitution, and says that the Constitution should be upheld and advanced.
